





Introduction

In this presentation, I'll explore the question: Can AI replace teachers in the future? Let's analyze both sides of this debate and imagine the future of AI in education.




Areas Where AI Can Help Teachers





- Several educational trials have explored AI's role in teaching without human instructors, and the outcomes often emphasize the irreplaceable value of human educators.
